Japan Cherry Blossom Tour

13 days

Departure: 31 March 2012

Sat, 31 Mar 12: Australia - Tokyo

Fly Malaysian Airlines to Tokyo via Kuala Lumpur departing at 15:30.

Sun, 01 Apr 12: Tokyo

Arrive in Tokyo at 07:15. We will be met by our national English speaking tour guide. Then set off to visit Tokyo National Museum, the largest museum in Japan. After your included lunch, check in at the **Grand Prince Hotel**, New Takanawa or similar for 3 nights. Evening ride over the Rainbow Bridge to Odaiba and enjoy a welcome dinner party.



Mon, 02 Apr 12: Tokyo

Full day city tour of Tokyo by private motorcoach. After breakfast, our tour guide will show us some of the city's main attractions, such as a boat ride on the Sumida River, the suburb of Asakusa with the Nakamise shopping mall and the Kannon Temple. After a lunch break, we will proceed to Ueno Park, famous for the cherry blossom viewing, Akihabara Electrical District. We will finally visit the fashionable Ginza district with its magnificent department stores.

Tue, 03 Apr 12: Tokyo – Nikko- Tokyo

Full day Nikko National Park tour by private motorcoach. Nikko National Park is one of the most important tourist destinations in Japan. The tour takes in the Toshogu Shrine dedicated to the memory of Tokugawa Ieyasu, the warlord who took control of all Japan and established the Shogunate which ruled for 250 years, until the Meiji Restoration ended the feudal era in 1867. After our included lunch we will visit Lake Chuzenji and Kegon Falls driving through the Irohazaka Zigzag. On the way back we will stop at Shinjuku for some free time to enjoy the neon lights spectacle before returning to your hotel.

Wed, 04 Apr 12: Tokyo – Hakone

Departure by private coach to Hakone National Park



This morning visit Hakone National Park, 90 km west of Tokyo. With Mt Fuji in the background and placid Lake Ashi, Hakone is surrounded by scenic mountains, hot springs and historic places. We will have lunch upon arrival in Hakone Town. The tour includes a cruise on Lake Ashi, an aerial cableway ride to view the ancient crater of Mt Kamiyama and climb to Owakudani, an area filled with sulphurous fumes and hot springs. While you are there try and eat the black spa eggs said to prolong one's life for 7 years. At the end of the visit we will check in at the **Hakone Palace Spa Hotel** or similar for 1 night. Dinner

Thu, 05 Apr 12: Hakone-Tsumago-Takayama

Continue by motorcoach to the historic Village of Tsumago in the heart of the Kiso Valley. Have lunch and time at leisure to wander around this old village before driving through the Japanese Alps to Takayama, also known as the "Little Kyoto". Check in at the **Hotel Associa Takayama Resort** for two nights including dinner and breakfast.

Fri, 06 Apr 12: Takayama-Furukawa-Takayama

Today you will visit the Miya-Gawa Morning Market, Hida Folk Village and chance to taste some local delicacies for lunch (own expense) as you wander about the Old Merchants Districts. Continue to Furukawa, a beautiful small town with riverside streets and visit Takumi Craft Museum for some hands on experience of craft work. Return to Takayama and enjoy dinner at hotel

Sat, 07 Apr 12: Takayama-Shirakawa-Kanazawa

After breakfast we will be leaving on a 1 hour drive across the Japanese Alps, to the 700 years old village of Ogimachi in the Shirakawa-go region, one of the best-preserved rural areas of Japan. Time at leisure to walk through and explore this enchanting village. We will continue driving through the Japanese Alps to Kanazawa and upon arrival visit Kenroku-en Park, one of the three most important gardens in Japan. It was constructed in the 17th century as an outer garden of the Kanazawa Castle and became a public park in 1817. Check in at the **Hotel ANA Crowne Plaza Hotel** or similar for 1 night.

Sun, 08 Apr 12: Kanazawa – Kyoto

This morning we will visit Higashi Chaya-gai and explore the traditional Geisha house known as Shima. Free time have lunch before leaving for Kyoto. Upon arrival in Kyoto we will experience a traditional tea ceremony at Kodaiji Temple before making our visit to Kiyomizu Dera temple and the Sannen-zaka area. Check in at the **New Miyako Hotel** or similar for three nights.

Mon, 09 Apr 12 Kyoto – Nara - Kyoto

Full day guided tour of Kyoto and Nara. This morning we will continue our visit of Kyoto, including the Kinkakuji Temple, Nijo Castle. After our included lunch, we will visit Nara, the ancient capital of Japan to experience Todai-ji Temple, the largest wooden structure in the world and Kasuga Shrine. This evening you will enjoy an exclusive Maiko (Geisha apprentice) Show and a traditional Japanese farewell dinner.

Tue, 10 Apr 12: Kyoto – Hiroshima – Kyoto

Full day guided Tour to Hiroshima and Miyajima Island. Experience the Shinkansen (bullet train) to Hiroshima. Visit the A Dome at the Peace Park to see the ruins of the only building left as a Memorial of the 1945 Atomic Bomb and continue to visit the Peace Memorial Museum. After a lunch break we will continue to the Sacred Island of Miyajima, the cradle of the Japanese Shinto religion and see the Floating Torii (Shinto shrine gate). Then return to Hiroshima station to board our bullet train back to Kyoto.



Wed, 11 Apr 12 Kyoto – Kuala Lumpur

Transfer to Osaka – Kansai International airport. Check in for our Malaysian Airlines flight back to Australia via Kuala Lumpur.

Day 1, TOKYO (Arrival)

Arrive at Narita International Airport (Tokyo) by your flight. After clearance of immigration and custom formalities, proceed to Ticket office to exchange your Japan Rail Pass to Rail Passport for the immediate use and at the same time reserved your seats for the long distance journey. **(Tokyo accommodation 3nights)**

Day 2, TOKYO

Full day sightseeing tour of Tokyo, including visiting: Tokyo Tower Observatory, Meiji Shrine, Imperial Palace East Gardens, Hama-rikyu Garden, Sumida River Cruise, Asakusa Kannon Temple and Nakamise Shopping arcade.

Day 3, TOKYO

Full day at your leisure, suggests visit Mt. Takao, an attractive sightseeing spot accessible by train in an hour.

Day 4, TOKYO – MT. FUJI – HAKONE

Leave Tokyo for full day excursion to Hakone. En route visiting incl Cruise on Lake Ashi, Ropeway ride and experience Onsen –hot spring at your hotel. **(Accommodation at Hakone)**

Day 5, HAKONE – TAKAYAMA

Morning visiting Kenrokuen Park, Higashi-chaya Street and Former Guest House "Shima". Afternoon travel to Kyoto by Limited Express Train "Raicho", (Kyoto accommodation 2 nights)

Morning sightseeing tour of Kyoto, including Nijo Castle, Kinkakuji Temple (The Golden Pavilion) and Kyoto Handicraft Centre.

Introduce to APPI Ski Resort:

APPI is located in the north eastern part of main island Japan, with latitude 40° N where world's famous ski resorts such as Austria's Arlberg and USA's Aspen are located. APPI ski resort is on Mt. Maemori (1305m/4281ft) and on Mt. Nishimori (1328m/4357ft), both in the Hachimantai National Park.
